#### From the Pastor

Dear Church,

Somebody told me that this month marks my tenure of serving as your Pastor at seven years...oh my, has it really been seven years? Sure enough. I remember preaching at St. Paul's for the first time in May of 2017 when you voted to approve me as your next Pastor. Joie came into the Pastor's Study off the side of the sanctuary after the congregational vote and gave me a hug. I was confident even then that God was guiding me throughout my life of ministry, but in hindsight I can say with certainty that God's hand has been on my shoulder through all the seasons of serving this church for the past seven years. I couldn't have done it, but by his grace and guidance.

Seven years feels significant for me. In the Bible, the number seven is a symbol of wholeness. In the beginning, God made the heavens and the earth in six days, and rested on the seventh day, and God blessed the seventh day and consecrated it as holy. In our church calendar, the liturgical season of Easter is seven weeks. And seven times seven equals the number of days between the first Easter and Pentecost (the 50th day), when God's Spirit blew in a totally new direction and birthed the church with Peter, James, John and Paul stumbling forward to preach sermons about the resurrected Jesus, and serve new Christians filled with grace and truth.

The chapter that is ending for me was one of first calling, of my family growing from two to five with the additions of our three children, of our church having many saints and pillars pass away while also adding new friends and members as we begin to grow younger. In the past seven years, we put a new roof over our heads, we hired new staff, we started new ministries, we survived a years-long pandemic, we're halfway towards a new boiler and from a certain perspective today we are in a healthy, relatively stable season. So, the seven-year chapter comes to a close with much to be grateful for. And a new chapter begins at Pentecost this May. How fitting! We pray for God's Spirit to blow once again and guide the church in our activities moving forward.

I pray: God, please call me to serve another seven years, this congregation, your church. As we begin another chapter of the life of this place, write a good story, help us to grow in grace, gratitude and love. Bless us with your abiding presence and move among us with power. Help us to forgive, to serve, to laugh, to work hard, to rest well and to delight in your plans for this church moving forward. Amen.



Carly Burns from Grandville Senior High School, granddaughter of Dennis & Darleen Burns. Plans to attend GRCC.



#### **Notes from the Green Committee**

St. Paul's UCC applied for and was selected to receive a free high-level Energy Audit by Lawrence Technical University's RESTART Program. The Michigan Department of Environment, Great Lakes and Energy (EGLE) paid Lawrence Technical for the audit and selected Diane Mills from Occupant Care to conduct the audit. Diane came to St. Paul's and met with representatives Steve Devine, Phyllis Allison, Andrew Soria, Deb DeBruyn and Pastor Matt. She was very thorough and seemed to understand our church's needs. She was also prompt in getting the audit back to us.

This audit identified energy efficiencies St. Paul's UCC can consider, including the need for a new boiler, and will be useful in applying for grants.
